Hot Springs Village Community Challenge

Who will be crowned Hot Springs Village Explorers?

Here's your opportunity to join the Hot Springs Village Recreation, Golf, Lakes and Food and Beverage Departments as we celebrate 50 years in Hot Springs Village.

We're hosting a 6-month team challenge that encourages Hot Springs Village members and/or their guests to get to know their neighbors and their community.

Teams will try new things, meet new people, and learn all about what their community has to offer.

Beginning in January 2020 and running through March 2020, we'll build excitement for the challenge by talking to clubs and organizations, social media posts, community information meeting (February 18, 19 2020), and social events to encourage team organization for the challenge.

Each team will choose a unique Team Name and will be issued passport lanyards to be used throughout the community challenge to identify them as participants. We are also looking into t-shirts identifying team members.

In April 2020 the Challenge begins with the Outdoor Pool Tours followed by a kickoff event with distribution of tasks.

Teams have from April 2020 to October 20, 2020 to complete the tasks. Special tasks and bonus tasks will be added through the Challenge period through various ways (Facebook, on-line, email, etc.)

On October 24, 2020 a luncheon and announcement of the overall winners will be held at Balboa Pavilion. Registration fee will be required for the luncheon.

Points are awarded for completing tasks. Points per task vary based on the task. Points for the challenge are logged at physical check-ins, by receipt (provided at specified locations), photos (sent to specified locations), and social media check-ins.

With six months to earn points, the task length will be extensive ... but definitely fun!

The winning team will have the most points at the end of the Challenge and be crowned Hot Springs Village Explorers. The winning team (up to ten members) will receive a prize package worth approximately \$3,750 per person consisting of unlimited greens fee, and annual passes to the fitness center, tennis center, pickleball, bocce ball, lawn bowling, library, outdoor pool and dog park.

Tasks will include activities at recreation, golf, food and beverage, lakes, local businesses, clubs and organizations, as well as some of our regional partners.

So, how does your organization, club or business get involved?

Each participating organization/business will provide a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 10 tasks to be used in the final listing (tasks can require purchases, volunteering, etc.)

A minimum of three tasks for each participating organization/business will be included in the final task list given to the team competitors during the kick off event in April 2020.

Each business/organization that participates must donate a door prize with a value of least \$25 for the October 24, 2020 luncheon.

If your business/organization is interested in participating, please complete the enclosed registration form and return to the Hot Springs Village Recreation Department. Final tasks for the challenge will be selected by the Recreation Department.
